Neighborhood Spotlight: Poplar Grove

Nestled within the westside is the Poplar Grove neighborhood. Established in 1993, the Poplar Grove Neighborhood Association traces its roots back to a conversation between neighbors, ignited by a shared vision for a stronger, more connected community.

In its infancy, Poplar Grove was defined by the towering poplar trees that graced its landscape, providing shelter and inspiration to those who called it home. These sturdy trees not only offered material for building homes but also lent their name to the burgeoning neighborhood.

At its core, the Poplar Grove Neighborhood Association is driven by a shared commitment to the welfare of its residents and the continual enhancement of its surroundings. Through initiatives aimed at fostering community engagement, promoting safety, and enhancing the quality of life for all. Members have been to many meetings at the Civic Center and have accomplished a number of things including:

- Getting sewers clean to prevent basement flooding
- Partnering with Western Terrace Neighborhood and neighborhood police officers to put cameras in their vehicles
- Advocating to keep the traffic light at Barker and Marion for Reitz High School
- Having Vectren remove a large electrical box so kids wouldn't have to walk in the road to get to Tekoppel School
- Prevented an Adult Bookstore from opening on Tekoppel Ave.
- Partnered with the West Sector Police Office and other West Sector neighborhoods to get a



light on Fulton Ave., Ninth Ave., and St. Joseph Ave. that indicates to drivers when a train is present on Ohio St.
